Deputy Director Jess Martinez oversees the Community Recreation and Educational Initiatives Child, Family Development and the Facility Maintenance Divisions within the Department of Family and Community Services. He has close to 25 years of experience with the City of Albuquerque's Community Recreation and Educational Initiatives Division. After graduating from the University of New Mexico with a Bachelor's Degree in Political Science, Mr. Martinez began his work with the Community Recreation Division, working part-time in the Playground recreation Program. Over the years, Mr. Martinez has climbed the ranks; managing community centers and eventually becoming the Division Manager, overseeing the activities of 22 community centers, 26 before and after school APS sites, 4 therapeutic recreation sites, 150 summer lunch sites, and the educational initiatives programs. Mr. Martinez's experience and passion for the development of Albuquerque's youth and families helping Mayor Keller's Administration meet its goal of increased youth services for the community.

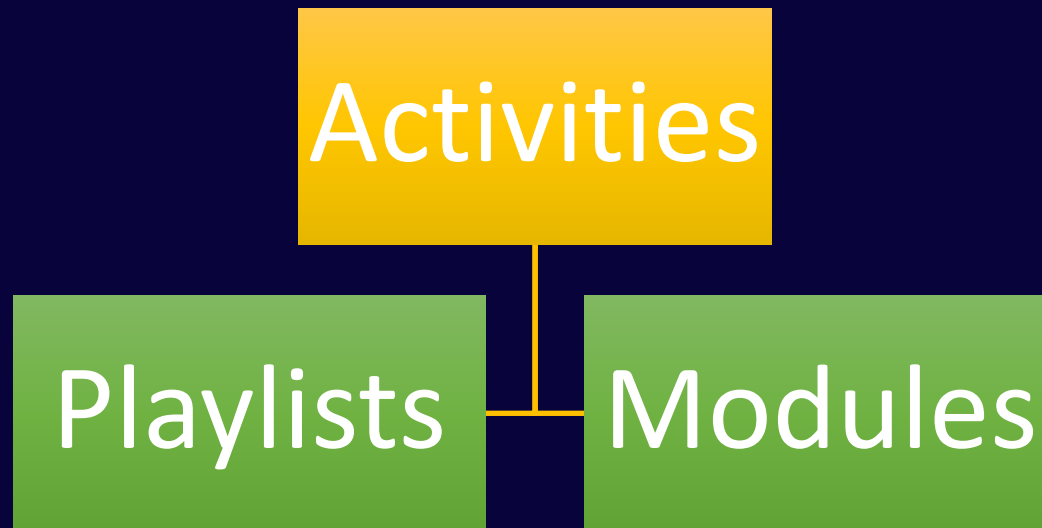

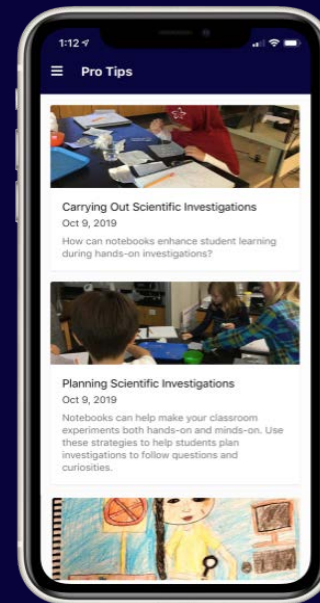
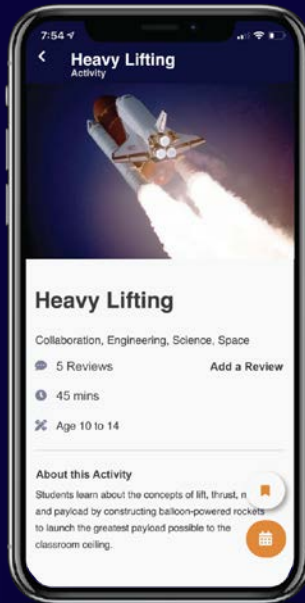
What is Mizzen by Mott?
